SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Leadership Metro Richmond is fortunate to have endowed and current scholarships for participants of Leadership Quest. Scholarships were created by graduates, corporations, foundations, and in memory of alums who have passed. The program scholarships exist to ensure the diversity of each class by sector, gender, ethnicity, socioeconomic level, and perspective. Scholarship requests do not influence the class selection process.

Scholarship assistance may be available to those who demonstrate valid need: "Ask for what you need, but please need what you ask for." Recipients may include leaders from organizations with limited training budgets, nonprofits with limited operational budgets and resources, volunteers, and others with specific circumstances. Awards generally range from a few hundred dollars to half the cost of the program. Higher awards are less common due to limited resources.

In return, we ask for your honesty in determining your need. Generally, scholarship requests far exceed what LMR can grant.
