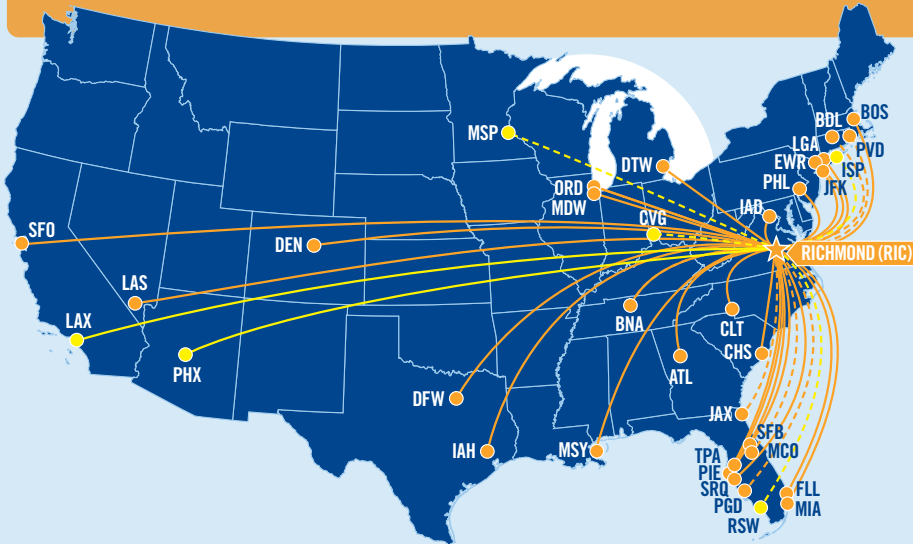

CENTRAL LOCATION

AIRLINES AND CARGO

Nine major airlines offer nonstop flights to major domestic destinations and connecting options to points around the world. RIC also features one of the busiest cargo facilities in the nation, handling a record 190 million pounds of cargo in fiscal year 2023.



ECONOMIC IMPACT

The activities of RIC and its tenants create nearly 16,000 jobs and contribute \$2.1 billion in economic activity annually to the Richmond region, according to the Virginia Department of Aviation. In fiscal year 2023, the Airport welcomed more than 4.4 million passengers.
